To include (not necessarily in this order) St John's, Garland Street Baptist Church (1834), Friends' Meeting House (1749-50), Cathedral of St James and St Edmund (1503 plus major work by our late President, Stephen Dykes Bower), St Mary's (third largest parish church in England), Unitarian Meeting House (1711), and the United Reformed Church (1692 with later work).

Purchase your own lunch (for example at the Cathedral Refectory). Tea will be provided by the host and organiser, Christopher Moore, at his home next door to the URC.

The tour will involve walking from building to building, and some uneven ground / steps.

Cost per head: £15.

Meet at St John's Church, St John's Street, at 11.30. where coffee will be served. This is five minutes south of the railway station. The 09.44 from King's Cross arrives at Bury St Edmunds at 11.23 (change at Cambridge).
